3. What personal data is collected

We need your name, address, date of birth, telephone number, email address, as well as health data, speech samples, videos, therapy data, and reports to contact you and exchange information.

Please note that communication over the Internet (e.g. email) may be subject to security vulnerabilities. It is impossible to completely protect data from access by third parties.

4. Purpose and legal basis

We process your data based on the EU-General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG), and any other data protection laws that are relevant to us.

We collect and store your data to contact you and provide information about KST. The processing is necessary for the performance of pre-contractual measures under Art. 6 (1) (b) GDPR.

5. Recipients of personal data

Data is only disclosed to third parties if KST has the authorization or obligation under applicable law.

We use data processors in various cases in accordance with Article 28 GDPR, who may receive data from us or have access to your data in connection with their services.

We attach particular importance to the reliability of our service providers and ensure that data storage takes place within Germany. We avoid data transfers to other countries and only make them if it is absolutely necessary for the purposes mentioned before.

6. Storage duration

The duration of the storage of your data depends on the statutory retention periods. According to §10 (3) of the Professional Code of Conduct for Physicians in Hesse, patient records must be kept for 10 years, unless longer retention periods are required by law. The period begins with the completion of your treatment. The retention period specified in the professional code of conduct is a minimum period.

The data of Kasseler Stottertherapie may be stored for evaluation purposes for a longer period.

7. Your rights

You have the right to obtain information about the personal data stored in KST under Art. 15 GDPR. Under Art. 16 GDPR, you can request the correction or completion of incorrect data.

You can request the deletion or blocking of data under Art. 17 or 18 GDPR.

You have the right to object to the storage of your data under Art. 21 GDPR. However, therapy participation is not possible without the storage of your data. You have the right to data portability under Art. 20 GDPR, which means you can receive the data stored in KST in a machine-readable format and transfer it to another controller of your choice.

8. Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority

Any person affected by data processing has the right under Art. 77 GDPR to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if they believe that the processing violates data protection law.
